

Guidelines for Booking Lessons 2019

Thank you for choosing Queenswood Stables

Lessons by Session

- The year will be divided in 4 sessions: Spring (March, April, May, June) Summer (July, August) Fall (September, October, November) and Winter (December, January, February)
- In order to guarantee your space at a certain lesson time, riders must either pay in advance for the entire session (discounted 5%) or provide post-dated cheques dated for the 22nd of each month prior to the course starting. (i.e. Nov 22nd for Winter session)
- For Package lessons, make-ups can be given at any time during the session but cannot be carried over to another session. In order to be granted a make-up lesson, the lesson MUST be cancelled 48hrs in advance <u>via e-mail only</u> (lessons@queenswoodstables.com). Queenswood reserves the right to book make-ups in any lesson format (ie. students having lessons with senior instructors may be allocated to a junior instructor lesson).

Monthly Lesson Package

- If riders choose to pay on a month to month basis, their space for the next month will not be guaranteed unless paid by the 22nd of the month prior and Queenswood reserves the right to allocate a different student to that space. Riders who have committed to the entire session will be given priority.
- Make up for lessons on a pay per month basis must be taken within the month of purchase. In order to be granted a make-up lesson, the lesson MUST be cancelled 48hrs in advance via e-mail only (lessons@queenswoodstables.com). Queenswood reserves the right to book make-ups in any lesson format (ie. students having lessons with senior instructors may be allocated to a junior instructor lesson).
- If there are 5 lessons in a month, the "extra" lesson must be paid as an individual lesson.

Individual Lessons Private or Group

• Pay-per-lesson students that have lessons booked in advance will not be entitled to any make-ups.

Junior Instructor Group Lessons: Individual \$60, Monthly Package of 4 is \$210

• Every effort will be made to fill the group, however if the group ends up consisting of only 2 to 3 riders, the lesson duration will be 45 minutes. For 4 to 6 riders, the lesson duration will be one hour.

Junior Instructor Private Lessons: Individual \$74, Monthly Package of 4 is \$280

• This is a 30 minute lesson with a Junior Instructor.

Junior Instructor Pony Ride Program: Individual \$40, Monthly Package of 4 is \$145

 This is a 30 minute session with a Junior Instructor for children 2-7 years old. It is 30 minutes long and consists of 15 minutes grooming and tacking up and 15 minutes riding time.

Senior Instructor Private Lesson 30 minutes: Individual \$86, Monthly Package of 4 is \$335
Senior Instructor Private Lesson 45 minutes: Individual \$96, Monthly Package of 4 is \$370
Senior Instructor Semi-Private Lesson 45 minutes: Individual \$74, Monthly Package of 4 is \$280

For all lessons, the students are asked to arrive approximately 20 minutes prior to their lesson to groom and tack up their assigned mount, except the Pony Ride Program participants, as it is included in their session. Every effort will be made to assist them as required, if staff is available, but it is not included in the lesson. Extra lessons can be booked to teach students more about grooming and/or tacking up horses. Beginner group lessons may include the time to teach students about grooming and tack as part of their lesson until they are comfortable doing it on their own. This means there may be less riding time until they are capable of readying their mounts on their own for the lesson start time.

Please Note: Proper footwear is required in the barn for everyone (parents, siblings, friends).

All riders MUST have a boot or shoe with a small heel.
